ABSTRACT

The initial inspiration in writing this thesis, which is entitled Analysis on the Theme of Orwell's Political Novel Nineteen Eighty-Four, is my curiosity of the idea of totalitarianism in the book. In order to discover how totalitarianism becomes the theme of the book, the backgrounds of Orwell in writing the book deserve a special attention.

It is therefore so obvious that this research has had a total focus on Orwell's last novel Nineteen Eighty-Four. The first aim of this research has been to discover Orwell's purpose in writing the book. The second aim has been to discover the characteristics of totalitarianism adopted in the book in which the ideology becomes the major theme of the book.
