

## ABSTRACT

This research was trying to explore the frequency of *so...that*, *such...that*, *...enough to infinitive*, and *too...to infinitive* adverbial clauses of result.

This research was also intended to classify *so...that*, *such...that*, *...enough to infinitive* and *too...to infinitive* adverbial clauses of result whether they belong to the high, medium, or low frequency level.

In composing this thesis, I used the data which were collected from the samples of 5 books of science, 3 books of literature, and 4 magazines. The sampling procedure was done by borrowing some books of science and books of literature from the library of Sanata Dharma University. Some magazines were lent by my lecturer, and some others were lent by my friend. All of the books and magazines were written by native writers.

In the research, there were 144 *so...that*, *such...that*, *...enough to infinitive*, and *too...to infinitive* adverbial clauses of result. Of the total number, there were 62 *so...that* adverbial clauses of result, 46 *...enough to infinitive* adverbial clauses of result, 33 *too...to infinitive* adverbial clauses of result, and 3 number of *such...that* adverbial clauses of result. From those numbers, they can be classified into 3 classification, namely, high, medium, and low frequency level. *So...that* belongs to the high frequency level, *...enough to infinitive* and *too...to infinitive* belong to the medium frequency level, and *such...that* belongs to the low frequency level.

In conclusion, *so...that* has the highest rank, because it is the easiest and the most practical way in expressing result. *...enough to infinitive* is not as easy and practical as *so...that* in expressing result, but it is easier compared with *such...that*. Accordingly, *...enough to infinitive* and *too...to infinitive* occupy the second rank, and *such...that* occupies the third rank.
