## **ABSTRACT**

LILIS: A Study of how Edwin Arlington Robinson Thinks of Life and his Expression of Life in the poem "Isaac and Archibald".

This study is an analysis of a poem "Isaac and Archibald". The objectives of the study are to find out whether the poem is an expression of Robinson's opinion about life, what the theme of the poem is and to find out what the poet actually wants us to learn from the poem.

Based on the principle that literature is the expression of the artist's experience, this study employs a biographical approach.
