

## ABSTRAK

### PERSEPSI SISWA, GURU DAN ORANG TUA SISWA TERHADAP KESIAPAN MENGHADAPI UJIAN NASIONAL

Studi Kasus : Siswa, guru dan orang tua siswa kelas 6 SD Kanisius Kalasan

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui : (1) ada tidaknya perbedaan yang signifikan antara persepsi siswa SD Kanisius Kalasan dengan persepsi siswa SD Kanisius Kadirojo terhadap kesiapan menghadapi Ujian Nasional, (2) ada tidaknya perbedaan yang signifikan antara persepsi guru SD Kanisius Kalasan dengan guru SD Kanisius Kadirojo terhadap kesiapan menghadapi Ujian Nasional, (3) ada tidaknya perbedaan yang signifikan antara persepsi orang tua siswa SD Kanisius Kalasan dengan persepsi orang tua siswa SD Kanisius Kadirojo terhadap kesiapan menghadapi Ujian Nasional.

Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian komparatif dengan populasi penelitian yaitu seluruh siswa kelas 6, seluruh guru yang mengajar dan seluruh orang tua siswa kelas 6. Teknik pengambilan sampel adalah probability sampling dan diperoleh 102 untuk sampel siswa, 18 untuk sampel guru dan 95 untuk sampel orang tua. Data dalam penelitian ini, yang meliputi persepsi siswa, guru dan orang tua dikumpulkan menggunakan kuesioner dengan Skala Likert yang terlebih dahulu dilakukan pengujian validitas dan reliabilitas. Teknik analisis data dalam penelitian ini menggunakan Uji t dengan bantuan komputer program *SPSS versi 12 for Window*.

Hasil pengujian menunjukkan bahwa : (1) ada perbedaan yang signifikan antara persepsi siswa SD Kanisius Kalasan dengan persepsi siswa SD Kanisius Kadirojo terhadap kesiapan menghadapi Ujian Nasional (*sign value* = 0,001 <  $\sigma$  0,05), (2) tidak ada perbedaan yang signifikan antara persepsi guru SD Kanisius Kalasan dengan persepsi guru SD Kanisius Kadirojo terhadap kesiapan menghadapi Ujian Nasional (*sign value* = 0,265 >  $\sigma$  0,05), (3) tidak ada perbedaan yang signifikan antara persepsi orang tua siswa SD Kanisius Kalasan dengan persepsi orang tua siswa SD Kanisius Kadirojo terhadap kesiapan menghadapi Ujian Nasional (*sign value* = 0,135 <  $\sigma$  0,05).

## ABSTRACT

### THE PERCEPTION OF STUDENTS, TEACHERS AND STUDENTS' PARENTS TOWARDS PREPARATION OF FACING THE NATIONAL EXAMINATION

A Case Study : Students, Teachers and Students' Parents of the Sixth Class

The purpose of this research is to understand whether: (1) there is any significant different perception between the students of Kanisius Kalasan Elementary School and Kanisius Kadirojo Elementary School in preparation of facing the National Examination: (2) there is any significant different perception between teachers of Kanisius Kalasan Elementary School and Kanisius Kadirojo Elementary School in preparation of facing the National Examination: (3) there is any significant different perception between students' parents of Kanisius Kalasan Elementary School and Kanisius Kadirojo Elementary School in preparation of facing the National Examination.

This research is a comparative research with the population of the sixth class, teachers and students' parents of Kanisius Kalasan Elementary School and Kanisius Kadirojo Elementary School. The technique of taking the samples in this research was *probability sampling*. The samples were 102 students, 18 teachers and 95 students' parents. The data in this research include the perception of the students, teachers and students' parents obtained by using questionnaire with Likert Scale to examine its validity and its reliability. The technique of analysing this research was T Exam with the help of *SPSS version 12 for Windows* computer program.

This result of the investigation shows that: (1) there is any significant different perception between the students of Kanisius Kalasan Elementary School and Kanisius Kadirojo Elementary School in preparation of facing the National Examination (*sign value* =  $0,001 < \sigma 0,05$ ); (2) there isn't any significant different perception between teachers of Kanisius Kalasan Elementary School and Kanisius Kadirojo Elementary School in preparation of facing the National Examination (*sign value* =  $0,265 > \sigma 0,05$ ); (3) there isn't any significant different perception between students' parents of Kanisius Kalasan Elementary School and Kanisius Kadirojo Elementary School in preparation of facing the National Examination (*sign value* =  $0,135 > \sigma 0,05$ ).
