

## ABSTRAK

### HUBUNGAN MINAT MENJADI GURU DAN IPK DENGAN BAKAT KEGURUAN MAHASISWA FKIP

Studi Kasus pada Mahasiswa S1 Angkatan 2013 FKIP Universitas Sanata Dharma

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui ada tidaknya: (1) hubungan antara minat menjadi guru dengan bakat keguruan mahasiswa FKIP; (2) dan hubungan antara IPK dengan bakat keguruan mahasiswa FKIP.

Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian Studi kasus yang dilaksanakan di Fakultas Keguruan dan Ilmu Pendidikan Universitas Sanata Dharma angkatan 2013 pada bulan Februari-Maret 2017. Teknik pengumpulan data yang digunakan adalah kuesioner dan dokumentasi. Jumlah sampel penelitian ini adalah 250 mahasiswa. Teknik pengambilan sampel adalah *Proportional Random Sampling*. Teknik analisis data adalah analisis deskriptif dan analisis *Korelasi Spearman*.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa: (1) tidak terdapat hubungan minat menjadi guru dengan bakat keguruan mahasiswa FKIP ( $Sig (2-tailed) = 0,652 > 0,05$ ); dan (2) tidak terdapat hubungan IPK dengan bakat keguruan mahasiswa FKIP ( $Sig (2-tailed) = 0,419 > 0,05$ ).

## ABSTRACT

### THE CORRELATION BETWEEN INTEREST IN BECOMING A TEACHER AND GRADE POINT AVERAGE AND THE TALENT OF STUDENT'S TEACHING ABILITY OF THE FACULTY OF TEACHER TRAINING AND EDUCATION

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The aims of this research is to find out the correlation between: (1) the interest in becoming a teacher and the talent of student's teaching ability of The Faculty of Teacher Training and Education; (2) grade point average and the talent of student's teaching ability of The Faculty of Teacher Training and Education.

This research is a case study which was conducted at The Faculty of Teachers Training and Education of Sanata Dharma University Yogyakarta. This research was conducted from February until March 2017. The data collection techniques were questionnaires and documentation. Samples of this study were 250 students which were taken by using proportional sample. The data analysis techniques were descriptive analysis and Spearman Correlation.

The results show that: (1) there is not correlation between the interest in becoming a teacher and the talent of student's teaching ability of The Faculty of Teacher Training and Education ( $Sig(2\text{-tailed}) = 0,652 > 0,05$ ); and (2) there is no correlation between grade point average and the talent of student's teaching ability of The Faculty of Teacher Training and Education ( $Sig (2\text{-tailed}) = 0,419 > 0,05$ ).
