

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini membahas penggunaan preposisi pada rubrik *Public Speaking* Harian Bernas bulan Maret-April 2016 yang ditulis oleh Lusy Laksita. Peneliti memilih rubrik ini karena ingin mengevaluasi apakah seorang *public figure* yang lebih dikenal di dunia praktik berbicara juga mampu berkontribusi dalam menulis di media cetak. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mendeskripsikan preposisi yang digunakan dan mengidentifikasi ketepatan penggunaan preposisi

Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian deskriptif kualitatif. Sumber datanya adalah 6 edisi rubrik *Public Speaking* pada surat kabar Harian Bernas dari bulan Maret-April 2016. Data penelitian ini berupa kalimat-kalimat yang menggunakan preposisi. Tahap analisis data mencakup reduksi data, mengelompokkan preposisi, menghitung frekuensi penggunaan preposisi, mengidentifikasi ketepatan penggunaan preposisi, mengidentifikasi kesalahan penggunaan, pembahasan, dan pembetulan kesalahan penggunaan preposisi.

Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa preposisi yang digunakan meliputi 16 buah preposisi: *antara, bagi, dalam, dari, daripada, dengan, di, ke, kepada, mengenai, oleh, pada, sampai, supaya, tentang, untuk*. Preposisi itu dipakai sebanyak 184 kali: ada 2 preposisi yang kurang tepat, yaitu (a) preposisi *dari* (3 kali), dan (b) preposisi *tentang* (1 kali).

Berdasarkan hasil penelitian, peneliti memberikan saran bagi redaksi/ editor, penulis rubrik *Public Speaking*, dan peneliti lainnya. Bagi redaksi/ editor penggunaan preposisi sudah baik hanya masih ditemukan struktur penulisan yang kurang sesuai, karena peneliti tidak menganalisis kaidah struktur penulisan, ini bisa menjadi menjadi koreksi. Bagi penulis rubrik *Public Speaking* surat kabar Harian Bernas, secara penggunaan preposisi sudah baik hanya karena peneliti tidak menganalisis struktur penulisan ada baiknya untuk lebih teliti pada kaidah penulisan agar kalimatnya lebih baik ketika dibaca oleh pembaca surat kabar. Bagi peneliti lain, penelitian ini masih relevan untuk diteliti lebih dalam lagi. Jika ingin melakukan penelitian sejenis diharapkan meneliti struktur kalimat atau penggunaan lainnya.

ABSTRACT

This research discussed the use of preposition in Public Speaking section of *Bernas Daily Newspaper* written by Lusy Laksita, published in a period of time during March-April 2016. The researcher took this rubric in order to be able to evaluate if a well-known public figure in a matter of public speaking could as well contribute in the matter of mass media written form. The research aimed to describe the use of preposition and identify the appropriate use of preposition.

This research was a qualitative descriptive study. The data sources of this research were six editions of Public Speaking sections of *Bernas Daily Newspaper* published during March-April 2016. The sentences containing prepositions became the data of the research. The stages of data analysis included the data reduction, the classification of preposition, the calculation of frequency of preposition use, the correct use of prepositions identification, the misuse classification, the discussion, and the corrections of the errors of preposition uses in a sentence.

The result of the research shows that there are seventeen (16) kinds of prepositions used, namely: *antara (between)*, *bagi (for)*, *dalam (in)*, *dari (from)*, *daripada (instead of)*, *dengan (with)*, *di (on)*, *ke (to)*, *kepada (direction to)*, *mengenai (of about)*, *oleh (by)*, *pada (at)*, *sampai (until)*, *supaya (so that)*, *tentang (about)*, *untuk (for)*. From the 184 prepositions which are used, there are two (2) prepositions which are used inappropriately: (a) preposition of *dari* (three times appeared), and (b) preposition of *tentang* (once appeared).

Based on the research findings, the researcher provides some suggestions for editors, writers of Public Speaking section, and also other researchers. For editors, the researcher finds out that the use of prepositions is already good. However, there are still some inappropriate uses in the writing structure, since the researcher did not analyze the rules of writing structure. Hence, this part could be improved. Next, for the writers of Public Speaking section, the researcher finds out that the use of preposition is also considered good. However, as already mentioned before, the researcher did not analyze the writer's rules of writing structure. Therefore, it would be better to be more careful on the rules of writing structure, so that the readers could read the points better. Finally, for other researchers, this research is in some ways still relevant to be investigated more deeply. It is suggested to examine the structure or other uses of the sentences.
