

ABSTRAK

PERBEDAAN PERILAKU AGRESIF PARA SISWA PUTRA DAN PUTRI KELAS II SMA N 2 PURBALINGGA TAHUN AJARAN 2004/2005

Penelitian ini adalah penelitian deskriptif bidang bimbingan dan konseling dengan menggunakan metode survai. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui perbedaan tingkat agresifitas para siswa putra dan putri kelas II di SMA N 2 Purbalingga Tahun ajaran 2004/2005. Populasi penelitian adalah para siswa kelas II SMA N 2 Purbalingga Tahun Ajaran 2004/2005 berjumlah 267 siswa, dengan sampel yang diambil berjumlah 136 terdiri dari kelas II A, II B, II C. Instrumen yang digunakan adalah angket perilaku agresif siswa. Teknik analisis data yang digunakan adalah perhitungan koefisien reliabilitas dan koefisien validitas, uji perbedaan dengan uji "t", perhitungan mean, perhitungan standar kesalahan perbedaan mean.

Masalah penelitian adalah apakah ada perbedaan perilaku agresif para siswa putra dan putri kelas II SMA N 2 Purbalingga Tahun Ajaran 2004/2005?. Hasil penelitian ini adalah (1) Secara keseluruhan terdapat perbedaan perilaku agresif antara siswa putra dan putri. Uji hipotesis menunjukkan perilaku agresif siswa putra lebih tinggi dari perilaku agresif siswa putri. (2) Dalam aspek menyerang fisik suatu obyek terdapat perbedaan perilaku agresif antara siswa putra dan putri. Uji hipotesis menunjukkan perilaku agresif menyerang fisik suatu obyek siswa putra lebih tinggi dari pada siswa putri. (3) Dalam aspek menyerang secara verbal/symbolis suatu obyek terdapat perbedaan perilaku agresif antara siswa putra dan putri. Uji hipotesis menunjukkan perilaku agresif menyerang secara verbal/symbolis siswa putra lebih tinggi dari siswa putri. (4) Dalam aspek menyerang hak milik atau menyerang daerah orang lain terdapat perbedaan perilaku agresif antara siswa putra dan putri. Uji hipotesis menunjukkan perilaku agresif menyerang hak milik atau menyerang daerah orang lain siswa putra lebih tinggi dari siswa putri.

ABSTRACT

THE DIFFERENCES OF AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIORS BETWEEN MALE AND FEMALE STUDENTS AT CLASS II OF SMA N 2 PURBALINGGA (PURBALINGGA STATE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL 2) DURING THE 2004/2005 LEARNING PERIOD

This was a descriptive research on guiding and counseling area with survey method. The research was aimed to identify the aggressiveness level of male and female students at class II of *SMA N 2* Purbalingga (Purbalingga State Senior High School 2) during the 2004/2005 learning period. Research population involved 267 class II students of *SMA N 2* Purbalingga during the 2004/2005 learning period with 136 samples taken from class IIA, B, and C. Instrument exploited was questionnaires on students' behavior aggressiveness. Data analysis techniques involved reliability and validity coefficient computation, significance test with t-test, mean computation, error standard computation, and mean difference.

Research problem was whether different behavior of aggressiveness between male and female students at class II of *SMA N 2* Purbalingga during the 2004/2005 learning period. Results indicated that (1) generally different aggressiveness behavior between male and female students was found. Hypothesis testing showed that aggressiveness behavior level of male students was higher than their female counterparts. (2) In term of physical attack on object, difference in aggressiveness behavior was detected between male and female students. Hypothesis testing showed that the physical attack of aggressiveness level among male students was higher than among their female counterparts. (3) In verbal /symbolic attack on objects, difference in aggressiveness behavior was detected between male and female students. Hypothesis testing showed that the verbal /symbolic attack of aggressiveness level among male students was higher than among their female counterparts. (4) In attack on others' properties or premises, difference in aggressiveness behavior was detected between male and female students. Hypothesis testing showed that the attack on others' properties or premises of aggressiveness level among male students was higher than among their female counterparts.
