


## Indonesian Legislators To Revise Law on Mass Organizations in 2018

The Indonesian House of Representatives (DPR) has scheduled to revise and rectify as many as 50 Bills during the 2018 Priority National Legislation Program or *Prolegnas* 2018. According to a member of DPR's Legislation Body, Asrul Sani, one of the Laws to be revised is supposed to be the new Law No. 2/2017 on Mass Organizations. It would be put, therefore, on the list consisting of 50 Bills already agreed to rectify during the *Prolegnas*.

[Law No. 2/2017 is derived from the regulation in lieu of law (Perppu) No.2/2017 which was, then, ratified Tuesday (on 24 October) by the House of Representatives (DPR) with some revisions.]

The legislator also said that it was only co-incidence that the bill No.39/2004 on Migrant Workers could be removed from the "final and agreed" *Prolegnas* list since its revisions had been done and legally rectified. Its position on the list would be, therefore, taken over by the new Law No. 2/2017.

"We have already co-ordinated with the government, making an agreement on the case mentioned above so that the bill No. 2/2017 could be on the list of *Prolegnas* 2018," said Asrul Sani in Jakarta on Monday (20 November).

It was reportedly said that the revisions should be immediately carried out as the follow up of DPR's decision (on 24 October) to ratify it with revisions.

The bills on the list to revise are, among others, that on Land Reform, Judge Positions, Sex Abuse, and many more.
