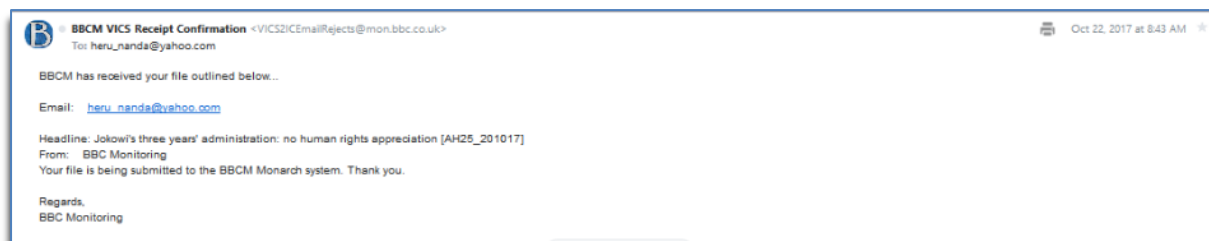


Jokowi's Three Years' Administration: No Human Rights Appreciation

The Director of the Amnesty International Indonesia National Office [AIINO] Usman Hamid has said that the promise made by President Jokowi to find the best solutions to the past human rights cases in the country has not been met yet.

The statement was made during the discussion on the evaluation of the three years' performance of President Jokowi's administration held at the office of AIINO in Jakarta on Thursday (19 October).

Mentioning about hard to appreciate the significant achievements made by Jokowi, however, he said that there was still time for Jokowi to improve his performance in dealing with the human rights in the country.

Not only did Usman talk about the many reports on unworthy actions done by Jokowi, but he also listed the crimes against human rights taking place during his three years' administration.

He said those abuses against human rights were, among others, dealing with freedom of expressions, religions, and organizations.

He concluded that the worst of all was Jokowi's lack of actions in finding the best solutions to the past human rights cases in the country.
