

ABSTRACT

The Difference in Self Self Confidence between Married Women and Unmarried Women in Klaten

The purpose of this research was to find out the difference in self confidence between married women and unmarried women in Klaten. The hypothesis that proposed is there is self confidence differences between married women and unmerried women in Klaten.

Subject in this research is married women and unmarried women. The total of the subject in this research are 35 married women and 35 unmarried women. Their ages are between 28-40 years old, have income below a million in a month, and stay in Klaten.

The sampling method used in this research was by disseminating the self confidence scale. The analyze data by t-test which gave result value of t-test 0,731 with probability 0,467 ($p > 0,05$). It means that there is no difference in self confidence between married women and unmarried women in Klaten.
