

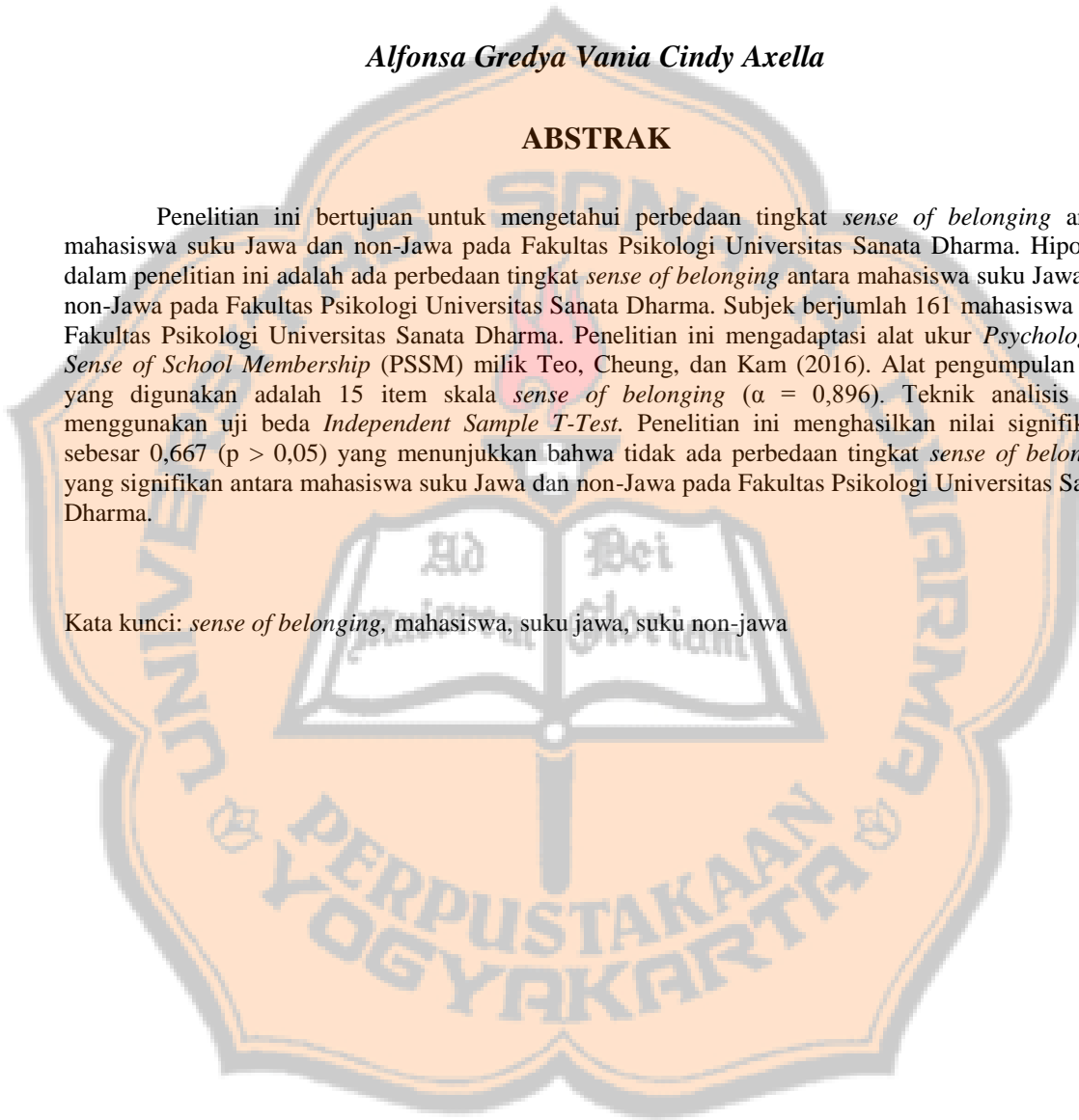
**PERBEDAAN TINGKAT *SENSE OF BELONGING*
ANTARA MAHASISWA SUKU JAWA DAN NON-JAWA
PADA FAKULTAS PSIKOLOGI UNIVERSITAS SANATA DHARMA**

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ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui perbedaan tingkat *sense of belonging* antara mahasiswa suku Jawa dan non-Jawa pada Fakultas Psikologi Universitas Sanata Dharma. Hipotesis dalam penelitian ini adalah ada perbedaan tingkat *sense of belonging* antara mahasiswa suku Jawa dan non-Jawa pada Fakultas Psikologi Universitas Sanata Dharma. Subjek berjumlah 161 mahasiswa aktif Fakultas Psikologi Universitas Sanata Dharma. Penelitian ini mengadaptasi alat ukur *Psychological Sense of School Membership* (PSSM) milik Teo, Cheung, dan Kam (2016). Alat pengumpulan data yang digunakan adalah 15 item skala *sense of belonging* ($\alpha = 0,896$). Teknik analisis data menggunakan uji beda *Independent Sample T-Test*. Penelitian ini menghasilkan nilai signifikansi sebesar 0,667 ($p > 0,05$) yang menunjukkan bahwa tidak ada perbedaan tingkat *sense of belonging* yang signifikan antara mahasiswa suku Jawa dan non-Jawa pada Fakultas Psikologi Universitas Sanata Dharma.

***THE DIFFERENCE IN SENSE OF BELONGING LEVEL
BETWEEN JAVANESE AND NON-JAVANESE STUDENTS
IN PSYCHOLOGY FACULTY OF SANATA DHARMA UNIVERSITY***

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to find out the differences in sense of belonging level between Javanese and non-Javanese students to Psychology Faculty of Sanata Dharma University. The hypothesis of this research is there are significant differences in sense of belonging level between Javanese and non-Javanese students to Psychology Faculty of Sanata Dharma University. The participants of this research are 161 active students of Psychology Faculty of Sanata Dharma University. This study adapted the Psychological Sense of School Membership scale by Teo, Cheung, and Kam (2016). The reliability coefficient of 15 items sense of belonging scale was $\alpha = 0,896$. The technique of data analysis being used was Independent Sample T-Test. The result shows a significant number as 0,667 ($p > 0,05$) which means there is no significant difference in sense of belonging level between Javanese and non-Javanese students to Psychology Faculty of Sanata Dharma University.
