More Indonesians Support Indonesia with Shari' a

The director of a noted Indonesian Survey Institution or LSI, Denny JA, has stated that the present Indonesian situation on facing with the presidential election has made more Indonesians support to NKRI [the Unitary of the Republic of Indonesia] with Shari' a [Islamic law], rather than those supporting Indonesia with Pancasila.

Mentioning such a finding was resulted from LSI's recent survey, he said that the numbers of Indonesians supporting Pancasila have been 10 per cent less than those during the past 13 years ago.

He also said Thursday (on 4 October) that in 2005 there were 85,2 per cent of Indonesian population supporting to Pancasila, in 2010 there were 81.7 per cent, in 2015 there were 79.4 per cent, while in 2018 there are only 75.3 per cent. It means that the numbers of Indonesian people supporting to Indonesia Shari' a has increased up to 9 per cent during the past 13 years.

According to LSI, 72.6 per cent of Indonesian people are worried about such a situation, while 7.5 per cent are not worried at all, and the other 13.9 per cent do not want to give any comment.
