

PERSEPSI TERHADAP RELASI INTIM ANTAR JENIS PADA PEREMPUAN DEWASA AWAL DENGAN ORANG TUA BERCREAI

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengeksplorasi persepsi perempuan dewasa awal dengan orang tua bercerai terkait relasi intim antar jenis, khususnya dari segi pemahaman dan penilaian. Penelitian ini adalah penelitian kualitatif dengan metode Analisis Isi Kualitatif terarah. Partisipan yang dilibatkan adalah tiga orang perempuan dengan rentang usia 21-23 tahun. Partisipan didapatkan dengan memilih orang-orang tertentu yang sesuai kriteria penelitian (*purposeful*). Pengambilan data dilakukan dengan wawancara semi terstruktur perorangan. Hasil dari penelitian ini adalah: (1) para partisipan memahami bahwa relasi intim melibatkan tiga komponen, yaitu keintiman, komitmen, dan *passion*, akan tetapi terlihat bahwa komponen keintiman lebih sering muncul sebagai komponen yang menggambarkan relasi intim; (2) penilaian para partisipan terhadap relasi intim antar jenis ada yang positif maupun negatif, akan tetapi penilaian mereka lebih cenderung positif serta lebih melibatkan komponen keintiman. Kesimpulan dari penelitian ini adalah (1) perempuan dewasa awal dengan orang tua bercerai cenderung memiliki pemahaman dan penilaian positif terhadap relasi intim antar jenis, khususnya terkait komponen keintiman yang diduga muncul karena mereka belajar dengan tidak meniru orang tua mereka serta berusaha memperoleh hal yang tidak ada dalam relasi orang tua mereka yang berakhir perceraian; serta (2) pemahaman dan penilaian negatif terkait relasi intim antar jenis yang diungkapkan oleh perempuan dewasa awal dengan orang tua bercerai diduga muncul akibat pengalaman negatif yang mereka rasakan ketika menjalin relasi intim maupun pengalaman pribadi merasakan apa yang dirasakan oleh orang tua mereka yang bercerai.

THE PERCEPTION OF INTIMATE RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE OPPOSITE SEX AMONG YOUNG ADULT WOMEN WITH DIVORCED PARENTS

ABSTRACT

The purpose of the current study was to explore the perception on intimate relationships with the opposite sex among young adult women with divorced parents, particularly in terms of understanding and evaluation. The current research was qualitative research using a directed qualitative content analysis method. The participants included three women aged between 21 and 23 years old. The participants were selected purposefully based on certain pre-determined criteria. The data retrieval were performed using semi-structured individual interviews, which executed individually. The results of the current research showed that (1) the participants understood that intimate relationships with the opposite sex involved three components, which were intimacy, commitment, and passion. However, it seemed that the intimacy component was most appeared as the component that described intimate relationships with the opposite sex; and (2) the participants' evaluation of intimate relationships with the opposite sex was both positive and negative, but their evaluation tend to be positive and was more likely to involve the intimacy component. The conclusions of this study were (1) young adult women with divorced parents tend to understand and evaluate intimate relationships with the opposite sex positively, especially when related to the intimacy component, which was estimated to have emerged because they had learned not to copy their parents and try to obtain things that do not exist in their divorced parents' relationships; and (2) it was estimated that the understanding and evaluation of intimate relationships with the opposite sex among young adult women with divorced parents would turned negative if they had negative experiences in a relationship with the opposite sex or if they experienced personally the same negative experiences as their divorced parents.
