Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui penerapan prinsip *Good Government Governance* yaitu prinsip demokrasi, transparansi, akuntabilitas, budaya hukum, kewajaran dan kesetaraan dalam pengelolaan Alokasi Dana Desa di Desa Bugisan Kecamatan Prambanan Kabupaten Klaten. Penelitian ini dilakukan untuk mengajak masyarakat berpartisipasi dan mengawasi proses pengelolaan ADD, serta meningkatkan pemahaman, kesadaran bagi perangkat desa dalam penyelenggaraan pemerintahan desa.

Jenis penelitian ini adalah studi kasus. Data diperoleh dengan menggunakan kuesioner, wawancara, dan observasi. Teknik analisis data yang digunakan adalah teknik analisis deskriptif kualitatif.

Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa Pemerintah Desa Bugisan sudah menerapkan prinsip *Good Government Governance* dalam pengelolaan Alokasi Dana Desa (ADD). Meskipun prinsip-prinsip sudah diterapkan dengan baik namun masih ditemukan pendapat dan masukan dari pihak perangkat desa maupun pihak masyarakat di setiap penerapan item prinsip GGG. Penerapan pada setiap item prinsip GGG memunculkan banyak saran sehingga Pemerintah Desa masih perlu mengevaluasi penyelenggaraan pemerintahan.

This research aims to determine the implementation of Good Government Governance principles namely democracy, transparency, accountability, legal culture, fairness and equity to village fund allocation at Bugisan Village, Prambanan, Klaten District. This research was conducted to improve participating and controlling village fund allocation's management as well as improving the understanding, awareness of the village officials in organizing village governance.

This research was a case study. Data were obtained through questionnaire, interview, and observation. The data was analyzed by descriptive qualitative analysis.

The result indicated that Bugisan's village government has applied the good government governance principles in village fund allocation. Although the principles have been applied however there are some opinions and suggestion from village officials and village community in each GGG principles. Implementation of GGG principles bring up a lot of good idea so that the village government still needs to reevaluate the organizing village governance.
