

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini membahas penggunaan kata ulang pada novel *Seoul, I Miss You* karya Christina Juzwar. Permasalahan yang dibahas dalam penelitian ini adalah (i) jenis kata dasar yang mengalami pengulangan dalam novel *Seoul, I Miss You* karya Christina Juzwar, (ii) jenis kata ulang dalam novel *Seoul, I Miss You* karya Christina Juzwar, dan (iii) makna kata ulang dalam novel *Seoul, I Miss You* karya Christina Juzwar.

Teori penelitian berupa kata ulang dalam novel *Seoul, I Miss You* karya Christina Juzwar. Pengumpulan data yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah metode simak. Peneliti menyimak data dari kalimat yang mengalami pengulangan dalam novel *Seoul, I Miss You* karya Christina Juzwar, kemudian diklasifikasikan. Dalam menganalisis data, peneliti menggunakan metode padan dan metode agih. Peneliti menggunakan metode padan referensial dan metode padan pragmatis. Teknik yang digunakan dalam metode agih adalah teknik ulang. Teknik selanjutnya yang digunakan dalam metode padan adalah teknik perluas.

Berdasarkan hasil penelitian, jenis kata dasar yang terdapat pada novel *Seoul, I Miss You* karya Christina Juzwar ada lima jenis yakni (i) kata kerja, (ii) kata keadaan, (iii) kata benda, (iv) kata keterangan, dan (v) kata numeralia. Selain itu, ditemukan lima jenis kata ulang dalam novel *Seoul, I Miss You* karya Christina Juzwar ada enam jenis kata ulang yakni (i) pengulangan seluruh, (ii) pengulangan sebagian, (iii) pengulangan dengan variasi fonem, (iv) pengulangan yang berkombinasi dengan pengimbuhan, dan (v) pengulangan progresif. Ditemukan ada empat makna kata ulang yakni (i) banyak tak tentu, (ii) ‘bermacam-macam’, (iii) ‘agak’, dan (iv) ‘perbuatan yang dilakukan berulang-ulang’ atau ‘frekuentatif’.

ABSTRACT

This study discusses the use of words in the Seoul, I Miss You novel written by Christian Juzwar. The problem discussed in this study are (i) the basic types by words that experience repetition in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar, (ii) the types of words repeated in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar, and (iii) the meaning of words repeated in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar. The purpose of this study is to describe the basic types of words that experience repetition in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar, to describe the types of words in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar, and to describe the meaning of repeat words in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar.

The research data is in the form of repetition words in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar. The data were collected by using observation method with uninvolved conversation observation technique and writing technique. The data were analyzed by looking at to the repetitive sentence in the Seoul, I Miss You by Christina Juzwar, and then the data were classified into its types. In analyzing the data, the researcher used the matching method and the aggregate method. Researcher uses the referention equivalent method and the pragmatic equivalent method. The technique used in the distribution method is repetition technique. The next technique used in the matching method is the expansion technique.

Based on the result of the study, there are five basic types of words found in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar, they are (i) verbs, (ii) adjective, (iii) nouns, (iv) adverbs, and (v) numeralia. In addition, several five types of words are found in the Seoul, I Miss You novel by Christian Juzwar, there are six types of words that are (i) whole repetition, (ii) partial repetition, (iii) repetition with reinforcement, (iv) repetition by inclusion, and (v) progressive repetition. It was found that there are four meanings of the word repeated which are (i) many indeterminate, (ii) ‘various’, (iii) ‘somewhat’, and (iv) ‘repeated acts’ or ‘frequency’.
