

ABSTRAK**PERBEDAAN TINGKAT KEDISIPLINAN SISWA
DARI KELUARGA TNI DAN NON-TNI**

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Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk: 1) mendeskripsikan seberapa tinggi tingkat kedisiplinan siswa yang berasal dari keluarga TNI dan Non-TNI. 2) Mengetahui dalam hal apa kedisiplinan siswa teridentifikasi capaian skor item pengukurannya rendah (belum optimal). 3) Mengetahui ada-tidaknya perbedaan tingkat kedisiplinan siswa dari keluarga TNI dan Non-TNI di SMA Angkasa Adisutjipto dan SMK Penerbangan AAG. Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian komparatif. Subjek penelitian adalah 32 siswa dari latar belakang keluarga TNI (AU, AD, AL) dan 32 siswa Non-TNI (PNS, buruh, wiraswasta, swasta, dll).

Pengumpulan data pada penelitian menggunakan kuesioner kedisiplinan siswa yang terdiri dari 50 item pernyataan. Kuesioner disusun berdasarkan aspek-aspek kedisiplinan menurut Prijodarminto (1994) yaitu (1) sikap mental, (2) Pemahaman yang baik mengenai aturan perilaku, dan (3) Sikap kelakuan yang menunjukkan kesungguhan hati untuk menaati aturan yang ada. Nilai koefisien reliabilitas instrumen menggunakan pendekatan Alpha Cronbach (α) sebesar 0,974. Teknik analisis data menggunakan teknik deskriptif kategori dan uji hipotesis dengan t-test.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan: 1) Sebagian besar siswa, baik dari keluarga TNI (56%) maupun Non-TNI (53%) memiliki tingkat kedisiplinan pada kategori sangat tinggi, dengan rincian; dari keluarga TNI; 18 siswa mempunyai tingkat kedisiplinan pada kategori sangat tinggi, 14 siswa pada kategori tinggi, dan tidak ada siswa berada di tingkat cukup, rendah maupun sangat rendah. Siswa dari latar belakang Non-TNI; 17 diantaranya berada di tingkat sangat tinggi, 14 diantaranya berada di tingkat tinggi, dan 1 diantaranya berada di tingkat cukup/sedang. 2) Tidak ada butir pernyataan di kuesioner kedisiplinan yang capaian skornya rendah/belum optimal. 3) Tidak terdapat perbedaan yang signifikan terkait tingkat kedisiplinan pada siswa dari latar belakang keluarga TNI maupun Non-TNI.

ABSTRACT***The Difference of Student's Discipline Level Coming from Indonesian National Armed Forces Family and non-Indonesian National Armed Forces Family***

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This research aims to (1) describe how high the students' discipline level who come from Indonesian National Armed Forces family and non-Indonesian National Armed Forces family, (2) know in what aspects the students' discipline level is identified by achievement score with low measurement (has not been optimized), (3) know whether there are difference of discipline level in the students' of Angkasa Adisutjipto High School and AAG Aviation Vocational High School who come from Indonesian National Armed Forces family and non-Indonesian National Armed Forces family. This research is a comparative research. The subjects of the research were 32 students from different Indonesian National Armed Forces family background (Indonesian Air Force, Indonesian Navy, Indonesian Army) and 32 students from different non-Indonesian National Armed Forces family background (civil servant, laborer, entrepreneur, private employees, and et cetera.)

In collecting the data, the researcher conducted a discipline-level questionnaire which consisted of 50 questions. The questionnaire was formed based on the discipline-level aspects according to Prijodarminto (1994) which are (1) mentality, (2) a good understanding about rules of conduct, and (3) behavior that shows the willingness to obey the rules. The instrument's reliability coefficient used Alpha Cronbach (α) Approach: 0,974. The data analysis technique used categorization descriptive statistics and hypothesis testing with t-test.

The result of the research shows that (1) most of the students, coming from Indonesian National Armed Forces family (56%) or non-Indonesian National Armed Forces family (53%) have tremendous discipline-level, with details; coming from Indonesian National Armed Forces family; 18 students have tremendous discipline-level, 14 students have high discipline-level, and no student is in enough, low, or super low discipline-level. Students coming from non-Indonesian National Armed Forces family; 17 students have tremendous discipline-level, 14 students have high discipline-level, and one student has enough discipline-level. (2) There is no statement in the discipline-level questionnaire that shows low/non-optimal score. (3) There is no significant difference related to the students' discipline-level who come from Indonesian National Armed Forces family and non-Indonesian National Armed Forces family.
