

## ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan antara kelekatan aman remaja akhir dan komunikasi seksual dalam keluarga. Hipotesis dalam penelitian ini adalah terdapat hubungan positif antara kelekatan aman remaja akhir dan komunikasi seksual dalam keluarga. Penelitian ini mendapatkan 200 partisipan dengan kriteria : remaja berusia 18 hingga 21 tahun. Metode pengambilan data dalam penelitian ini menggunakan survei *daring* atau *google form*. Alat ukur yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah skala *self-report* adaptasi skala *Inventory of Parent and Peer Attachment* (IPPA) yang disusun Armsden dan Greenberg (1987) dan adaptasi skala *Family Sex Communication Quotient* (FSCQ) yang disusun oleh Warren dan Neer (1986). *Inventory of Parent and Peer Attachment* (IPPA) memiliki reliabilitas alpha cronbach sebesar 0,946 dan untuk skala *Family Sex Communication* (FSCQ) didapati koefisien reliabilitas alpha cronbach sebesar 0,894. Data penelitian dianalisis menggunakan uji Analisis korelasi dengan teknik *Pearson Product Moment*. Hasil uji korelasi menunjukkan bahwa terdapat hubungan positif dengan nilai koefisien korelasi 0,421 dan nilai signifikansi (p) sebesar 0,00. Hasil tersebut dapat dimaknai bahwa semakin tinggi kelekatan aman maka semakin tinggi komunikasi seksual dalam keluarga. Sebaliknya, semakin rendah kelekatan aman maka semakin rendah komunikasi seksual dalam keluarga.

**ABSTRACT**

The main objective of this study is to investigate the correlation between late adolescent secure attachment and family sex communication. The proposed hypotheses were there is a positive relationship between late adolescent secure attachment and family sex communication. The research participants were 200 people ( $N = 200$ ) with some criterions; adolescents aged 18 to 22 years. The data collected by online surveys or google form. The instrument used in this study wereself-report scale that was adapted by researcher from the Inventory of Parent and Peer Attachment (IPPA) by Armsden dan Greenberg (1987) and Family Sex Communication Quotient (FSCQ) by Warren dan Neer (1986). The reliability coefficients on the Inventory of Parent and Peer Attachment (IPPA) scale is 0.946 and on the Family Sex Communication scale is 0.894. The data were analyzed usingthe correlation analysis test with the Pearson Product Moment technique. The resultof this study showed positive correlation between late adolescent secure attachment and family sex communication with a correlation coefficient value of 0.421 and a significance value ( $p$ ) of 0.00. These results that the higher the secure attachment, the higher the sexual communication in the family. Otherwise, the lower the secureattachment, the lower the sexual communication within the family.
