Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan antara konformitas dan perilaku merokok pada mahasiswa. Hipotesis penelitian ini adalah terdapat hubungan positif antara konformitas dengan perilaku merokok pada mahasiswa. Pengumpulan data dilakukan dengan menyebarkan kuisioner penelitian yang terdiri dari dua instrumen ukur yang dibuat sendiri oleh peneliti, yaitu skala konformitas (13 item, $\alpha = 0,763$) dan angket perilaku merokok. Hasil uji korelasi menunjukkan hasil koefisien korelasi (r) 0,872 dengan nilai probabilitas sebesar (p) = 0,000. Dari hasil tersebut dapat disimpulkan bahwa hipotesis penelitian diterima. Dengan kata lain, semakin tinggi konformitas, maka semakin tinggi perilaku merokok pada mahasiswa.

ABSTRACT

The aim of this research was to determine the correlation between conformity and smoking behaviour in female university students. The hypothesis of this study is that there is a positive relationship between conformity and smoking behaviour in female university students. Data collection was carried out by distributing research questionnaires consisting of two measuring instruments made by the researcher, namely the conformity scale (13 items, $\alpha = 0.763$) and the smoking behaviour questionnaire. The results of the assumption test showed that the data did not fulfil the normality requirement, but fulfilled the linearity requirement. Therefore, the data analysis technique used in this study is Spearman's rho. The correlation test results showed a correlation coefficient (r) of 0.872 with a probability value of (p) = 0.000. From these results it can be concluded that the research hypothesis is accepted. In other words, the higher the conformity, the higher the smoking behaviour in female students.
