

ABSTRAK

**PANDANGAN *VOLUNTEER* TENTANG IMPLEMENTASI
NILAI “*MEN AND WOMEN FOR OTHERS*” DALAM PARTISIPASI
DI PERKAMPUNGAN SOSIAL PINGIT, YOGYAKARTA**

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Perkampungan Sosial Pingit menjadi salah satu komunitas karya sosial yang menarik banyak perhatian anak muda khususnya mahasiswa di Yogyakarta. Bersama dengan para frater Serikat Yesus (SJ), para *volunteer* didampingi untuk melayani anak-anak dan warga binaan di Perkampungan Sosial Pingit. Walaupun motivasi melayani setiap *volunteer* beragam di awal tetapi perasaan baik membuat partisipasi semakin meningkat untuk melakukan *volunteering* atau kegiatan sukarela. Hal ini sejalan dengan salah satu nilai Spiritualitas Ignasian yaitu “*Men and Women for Others*”. Rumusan pokok penelitian ini mengarah pada bagaimana pengetahuan *volunteer* pada nilai “*Men and Women for Others*” dan implementasi nilai “*Men and Women for Others*” dalam partisipasi di Perkampungan Sosial Pingit, Yogyakarta. Jenis penelitian ini adalah kualitatif deskriptif dan penulis menggunakan teknik observasi dan wawancara terstruktur untuk mengumpulkan data lalu diuji keabsahannya dengan validator data. Jumlah informan dalam penelitian ini ada 7 *volunteer* yang masih terlibat aktif dan 2 frater SJ sebagai validator data. Tentu data yang diperoleh dianalisis dengan cara mereduksi data, menyajikan data, dan menarik kesimpulan. Hasil dari penelitian ini menyatakan *volunteer* beragama Katolik yang adalah informan mengetahui nilai “*Men and Women for Others*” dengan baik. Informan dan *volunteer* beragama non-Katolik tanpa sadar sudah melaksanakan nilai “*Men and Women for Others*”. *Volunteer* melaksanakan nilai tersebut dengan cara memberikan diri untuk melayani sesama dan berpartisipasi aktif dalam *volunteering*.

ABSTRACT

***VOLUNTEERS' PERSPECTIVES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION
OF "MEN AND WOMEN FOR OTHERS" VALUES IN PARTICIPATION
AT PINGIT SOCIAL VILLAGE, YOGYAKARTA***

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Pingit Social Village has become one of the social work communities that attracts significant attention from young people, particularly students in Yogyakarta. Together with the friars of the Society of Jesus (SJ), volunteers are accompanied to serve children and community members in Pingit Social Village. Although each volunteer's initial motivation to serve varies, positive feelings lead to increased participation in volunteering or voluntary activities. This aligns with one of the values of Ignatian Spirituality, namely "Men and Women for Others". The main formulation of this research focuses on volunteers' knowledge of the "Men and Women for Others" value and the implementation of the "Men and Women for Others" value in participation at Pingit Social Village, Yogyakarta. This research is descriptive qualitative, and the author uses observation techniques and structured interviews to collect data, which is then tested for validity with data validators. The number of informants in this study consists of 7 volunteers who are still actively involved and 2 SJ friars as data validators. The obtained data is analyzed by reducing data, presenting data, and drawing conclusions. The results of this research indicate that Catholic volunteers who are informants know the "Men and Women for Others" value well. Non-Catholic informants and volunteers have unconsciously implemented the "Men and Women for Others" value. Volunteers implement this value by giving themselves to serve others and actively participating in volunteering.
