**PENGHAYATAN SPIRITUALITAS IGNASIAN DALAM PELAYANAN

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mendeskripsikan penghayatan spiritualitas Ignasian dalam pelayanan anggota Cana Community di Kapel St. Robertus Bellarminus Universitas Sanata Dharma serta mengidentifikasi tantangan yang mereka hadapi dalam menghayati spiritualitas tersebut. Penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif dengan metode studi kasus. Subjek penelitian terdiri atas sepuluh anggota Cana Community sebagai informan dan dua pendamping sebagai validator. Teknik pengumpulan data dilakukan melalui studi dokumen, observasi partisipasi, dan wawancara mendalam. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa penghayatan spiritualitas Ignasian oleh anggota Cana Community tampak dalam prinsip-prinsip *Ad Maiorem Dei Gloriam*, *Magis*, *discernment*, dan *cura personalis* yang saling terkait dalam dinamika pelayanan. Para anggota memaknai pelayanan sebagai panggilan iman, berusaha memberikan yang terbaik, merefleksikan pilihan pelayanan secara sadar, serta membangun relasi yang penuh perhatian dalam komunitas. Meskipun demikian, para anggota juga menghadapi berbagai tantangan, seperti keterbatasan waktu, kelelahan, kurangnya pemahaman konseptual, serta dinamika relasi antaranggota. Penelitian ini menyimpulkan bahwa penghayatan spiritualitas Ignasian dalam Cana Community merupakan suatu proses yang berlangsung secara bertahap dan terus berkembang melalui pengalaman pelayanan, refleksi pribadi, serta pendampingan rohani. Penghayatan ini tidak hanya meningkatkan kualitas pelayanan, tetapi juga membentuk kedewasaan iman dan komitmen para anggota sebagai pelayan Gereja.

This study aims to describe the lived experience of Ignatian spirituality in the ministry of Cana Community members at St. Robertus Bellarminus Chapel, Sanata Dharma University, and to identify the challenges they face in living out this spirituality. This research employs a qualitative approach using a case study method. The participants consist of ten Cana Community members as informants and two spiritual companions as validators. Data were collected through document analysis, participant observation, and in-depth interviews. The findings indicate that the lived experience of Ignatian spirituality is reflected in the interconnected principles of Ad Maiorem Dei Gloriam, Magis, discernment, and cura personalis within the dynamics of ministry. The members understand ministry as a call of faith, strive to give their best, reflect consciously on their service decisions, and build caring relationships within the community. Nevertheless, they encounter various challenges such as time constraints, fatigue, limited conceptual understanding, and interpersonal dynamics. This study concludes that the lived experience of Ignatian spirituality in the Cana Community is a gradual and ongoing process shaped by ministry experiences, personal reflection, and spiritual accompaniment. This experience not only enhances the quality of ministry but also fosters the members' spiritual maturity and commitment as servants of the Church.
