

ABSTRAK

Skripsi ini mengkaji Dimensi Eklesiologis Karisma Pendiri *Congregatio Imitationis Jesu* (CIJ) berdasarkan Anjuran Apostolik *Vita Consecrata*. Kongregasi ini didirikan oleh Mgr. Henricus Leven, SVD sebagai tanggapan terhadap berbagai bentuk penderitaan masyarakat, khususnya kemiskinan, keterbatasan akses pendidikan dan kesehatan, serta ketidakadilan sosial.

Penelitian ini penting karena kajian mengenai karisma kongregasi religius selama ini lebih banyak menyoroti aspek historis dan institusional, sementara dimensi eklesiologisnya dalam terang *Vita Consecrata* belum banyak mendapat perhatian. Kebaruan penelitian ini terletak pada upaya memahami karisma pendiri CIJ dalam perspektif eklesiologi *communio*, sehingga memperkaya refleksi teologis mengenai hidup bakti sebagai karunia Roh Kudus bagi Gereja.

Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif-analitis dengan pendekatan studi pustaka. Data diperoleh melalui kajian terhadap Konstitusi CIJ tahun 1940 dan 2005, Anjuran Apostolik *Vita Consecrata*, serta berbagai dokumen Gereja dan sumber teologis yang relevan. Analisis dilakukan untuk mengidentifikasi dan menafsirkan dimensi eklesiologis karisma belas kasih dalam kehidupan dan perutusan kongregasi.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa karisma pendiri CIJ merupakan partisipasi dalam perutusan Gereja yang berakar pada pengalaman iman pendiri dan terus dihidupi dalam kehidupan kongregasi. Dalam terang *Vita Consecrata*, karisma tersebut dipahami sebagai *memoria evangelica* yang menghidupkan kembali semangat Injil dalam kehidupan Gereja. Penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa karisma belas kasih CIJ memiliki dimensi kristologis, eklesiologis, dan misioner yang saling berkaitan. Karisma tersebut tidak hanya membentuk identitas spiritual kongregasi, tetapi juga mengarahkan keterlibatannya dalam bidang pendidikan, kesehatan, sosial, dan pastoral sebagai wujud nyata partisipasi dalam misi Gereja. Temuan ini menegaskan bahwa karisma belas kasih CIJ bukan sekadar warisan spiritual internal kongregasi, melainkan karunia Roh Kudus yang memperkaya kehidupan Gereja, mendukung pembaruannya, dan menghadirkan kasih Allah secara konkret di tengah dunia.

ABSTRACT

This thesis examines the ecclesiological dimensions of the charisma of the founder Congregatio Imitationis Jesu (CIJ) based on the Apostolic Exhortation Vita Consecrata. This congregation was founded by Mgr. Henricus Leven, SVD, as a response to various forms of people's suffering, especially poverty, limited access to education and health care, and social injustice.

This research is important because studies on the charisma of religious congregations have so far focused more on historical and institutional aspects, while its ecclesiological dimension in the light of Vita Consecrata has not received much attention. The novelty of this research lies in the effort to understand the founder's charisma of CIJ from the perspective of ecclesiology communio, thereby enriching theological reflection on consecrated life as a gift of the Holy Spirit for the Church. This research uses a descriptive-analytical method with a literature study approach. Data were obtained through a study of the CIJ Constitutions from 1940 and 2005, the Apostolic Exhortation Vita Consecrata, and various relevant Church documents and theological sources. The analysis is carried out to identify and interpret the ecclesiological dimension of the charisma of compassion in the life and mission of the congregation.

The research findings show that the charisma of the founder of the CIJ is participation in the Church's mission, rooted in the founder's experience of faith and continually lived out in the life of the congregation. In the light of Vita Consecrata, this charisma is understood as memoria evangelica that rekindles the spirit of the Gospel in the Church's life. This study shows that the CIJ's charisma of charity has Christological, ecclesiological, and missionary dimensions that are interconnected. This charisma not only shapes the congregation's spiritual identity, but also directs its involvement in the fields of education, health, social work, and pastoral care as a concrete expression of participation in the Church's mission. These findings affirm that the CIJ's charisma of charity is not merely an internal spiritual heritage of the congregation, but a gift of the Holy Spirit that enriches the Church's life, supports its renewal, and brings God's love concretely into the world.
