

**PENGARUH *PERCEIVED SOCIAL SUPPORT* PADA
CAREER ADAPTABILITY MAHASISWA TINGKAT AKHIR**

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ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui pengaruh *perceived social support* pada *career adaptability* mahasiswa tingkat akhir. Subjek penelitian adalah 250 mahasiswa tingkat akhir di Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta. *Career adaptability* adalah kesiapan individu menghadapi tugas untuk mempersiapkan diri dan berperan dalam pekerjaan, sedangkan *perceived social support* adalah persepsi atau perasaan individu menerima bantuan dari orang lain. Hipotesis penelitian ini adalah *perceived social support* berpengaruh positif pada *career adaptability* mahasiswa tingkat akhir. Penelitian berjenis kuantitatif kausal Penelitian berjenis kuantitatif kausal untuk menyelidiki pengaruh satu variabel pada variabel lain. Alat pengukuran dalam penelitian ini menggunakan skala *career adaptability* dan skala *perceived social support* yang dikonstruksikan dengan model penskalaan Likert. Teknik analisis yang digunakan dalam penelitian adalah analisis regresi linear dengan program SPSS 22.0. Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa *perceived social support* berpengaruh positif dan signifikan pada *career adaptability* ($r^2 = 0,230$ dan $p = 0,000$).

**THE EFFECT OF PERCEIVED SOCIAL SUPPORT ON
CAREER ADAPTABILITY FINAL YEAR STUDENTS**

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ABSTRACT

This study aimed to investigate the effect of perceived social support on career adaptability final level students. Subjects in this study were 250 final year students in Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta. Career adaptability is the readiness of individuals faced with the task to prepare and participate in the work, while perceived social support is the perception or feelings of individuals receiving help from others. The hypothesis of this study is perceived social support positive effect on career adaptability final level students. This research is quantitative causal research to investigate the effect of one variable on other variables. This research used scale measurement of career adaptability and scale measurement of perceived social support that constructed with Likert model. The analysis technique used in the study is the linear regression analysis using SPSS 22.0. The results of this study showed that perceived social support positive and significant impact on career adaptability ($r^2 = 0.230$ and $p = 0.000$).
