

ABSTRACT

This study was intended to design a set of Communicative English Instructional Speaking Materials for Social Workers at *Ghifari NGO in Yogyakarta*. The design aimed at fulfilling the needs of Social Workers at Ghifari NGO in learning English related their job.

This study was concerned with two problems. The first problem dealt with how is a set of Communicative English Instructional Speaking Materials for Social Workers at *Ghifari NGO Yogyakarta* designed. The second problem dealt with how the set of Communicative English Instructional Speaking Materials for Social Workers at *Ghifari NGO in Yogyakarta* look like. In order to answer the problems the writer conducted library study and survey study. The library study was conducted to provide theoretical background to the designing materials. The survey study was aimed at conducting need analysis and evaluating the designed materials.

In designing the materials, the writer combined two instructional materials design models, Banathy's and Kemp's as the basis to design a set of Communicative English Instructional Speaking Materials for Social Workers at *Ghifari NGO Yogyakarta*. The steps were stated as follows: conducting need analysis, selecting, goals, topics, and objectives, selecting and developing syllabus type, system designing or material designing, selecting teaching and learning activities, evaluating the materials, and revising materials. There were eight (8) units developed in this study which emphasized on developing learners' speaking skill. Each unit consisted of five sections, namely Warming Up, Input, Language Focus, Language Practice, and Communicative Activities.

From the second survey study, the evaluation on the designed materials was obtained. The survey study involved two (2) English Instructors of Alpha English Course, (3) three instructors of Puri English Course and (1) one teacher of SMU Negeri 9 Yogyakarta. The descriptive statistic of the respondents' opinion on the designed materials showed that the average degree of agreement range from 3.7-4.0 on five-point scale. So it could be concluded that the designed materials were good and acceptable.

Finally, the writer hopes that the designed set of materials will be useful to social workers at Ghifari NGO in Yogyakarta in helping them to communicate with the foreign observers and donators.
