

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini mengkaji penggunaan struktur kalimat dan kelengkapan unsur kalimat pada Tajuk Rencana Surat Kabar Harian *Suara Merdeka* Edisi 2-7 November 2015. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mendeskripsikan struktur kalimat dan kelengkapan unsur kalimat.

Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian deskriptif kualitatif. Pengumpulan data mencakup pengumpulan surat kabar harian *Suara Merdeka* Edisi 2-7 November 2015, membaca tajuk rencana, menandai kalimat yang terdapat di dalamnya, dan menggumpulkan semua kalimat yang sudah ditandai. Analisis data dilakukan dengan membaca kalimat yang sudah dikumpulkan dan diidentifikasi unsurnya, mengelompokkan kalimat berdasarkan kelengkapan unsur kalimatnya, dan mendeskripsikan struktur kalimat serta kelengkapan unsur kalimat yang terdapat dalam tajuk rencana di surat kabar harian *Suara Merdeka*.

Dari hasil analisis dapat ditarik kesimpulan: pertama, dalam tajuk rencana terdapat struktur kalimat tunggal sebanyak 196 buah, kalimat majemuk setara sebanyak 27 buah, kalimat majemuk bertingkat sebanyak 73 buah, kalimat majemuk campuran sebanyak 5 buah, dan kalimat yang tidak memiliki kejelasan struktur kalimatnya sebanyak 1 buah. Kedua, dalam tajuk rencana juga terdapat kalimat yang unsurnya tidak lengkap, yaitu kalimat tunggal kekurangan unsur S (subjek) sebanyak 4 buah, kalimat majemuk setara kekurangan unsur S (subjek) sebanyak 3 buah, kalimat majemuk bertingkat kekurangan unsur S (subjek) sebanyak 4 buah dan kalimat yang tidak memiliki kejelasan struktur kalimatnya sebanyak 1 buah.

Berdasarkan hasil penelitian di atas, disarankan penelitian ini menjadi bahan pertimbangan redaktur surat kabar untuk tetap memperhatikan penggunaan struktur kalimat. Peneliti juga berharap peneliti lain meneliti hal yang sejenis khususnya struktur paragrafnya.

ABSTRACT

This study examines the use of sentence structure and sentence elements of completeness on Editorial *Suara Merdeka* daily newspaper 2-7 November 2015 edition. The purpose of this study to describe the structure of the sentence and the completeness of the sentence.

This research is a qualitative descriptive study. The data collection includes the collection of *Suara Merdeka* dayli newspaper 2-7 November 2015 edition, the plan of reading headers, mark the phrase contained in it, and herd all the sentences that have been marked. The data is analysis was carried out by reading the sentence that has been collected and identified it's elements, classifying sentences based on the completeness of the sentence, and described the sentence structure as well as the completeness of the sentence contained in an editorial in the *Suara Merdeka* daily newspaper.

From the analysis of data, it can be concluded: first, in the editorial structure exists single sentence of as much as 196 pieces, compound sentences equivalent of as many as 27 pieces, compound sentences-rise as much as 73 pieces, compound sentences mixture of 5 pieces, and the sentence which lacks clarity sentence structure as much as 1 piece. Second, the editorial also contained a sentence that element is not complete, that single sentence shortage element S (subject) of 4 pieces, complex sentences similar shortage of the element S (subject) of 3 pieces, compound sentences storey shortage element S (subject) of 4 fruit and sentences that do not have the clarity of the sentence structure as much as 1 piece.

Based on the result of the study, it is suggested this study into consideration the newspaper's editor still consider the use of sentence structure. Researchers also hope other researchers examining similar case in particular paragraph structure.
